KidSpace Summer Camp



Parents: Thank you for your interest in our Summer Camp here at Nashville Methodist Church. We will offer Bible Lessons, music, activities, games, field trips and lots of fun at camp. Summer Camp are for school age students 5 years of age through age 10. Our hours are 7:15-6:00 Monday- Friday. Mrs. Krisi House will be our Lead Staff member here at camp this year. Please reach out to her with questions or concerns 252-459-7636. April 3, 2023 is when applications will be accepted. Members of the church will be considered first. Registration for church members is \$25.00 and \$50.00 for non-members. Our weekly rate will be \$140.00. Cost will include two field trips. Campers will need to bring their lunch and a morning and afternoon snack each day.

In order to provide adequate staffing you must sign up for the weeks you want your camper to come to camp. You will be responsible for payment of the weeks you sign up for Summer Camp. We will need to know what weeks you need for your camper at the time you sign-up. Payments for weekly camp are to be paid in advance. Please pay Monday mornings when camp week starts.

Campers must be self-sufficient in the restroom, be completely toilet trained and be able to change clothes for any water activities.

We will announce field trips the week before. All campers must be able to listen and follow directions at camp to be able to attend field trips.

At any point if a camper becomes disruptive to the group, parents will be notified. If there are more than three incidents, we may have to dismiss the camper from the program.

If your camper has fever, excessive cough, mucus of color, diarrhea, vomiting, a rash or other illness they should not come to camp. They must be symptom free for 24 hours without medication to come back to camp.

Lice can be a problem at camp, we ask if your camper has long hair that it is put in a high ponytail. There is also a spray on the market to deter lice.
